- 10-11/60 COUNCILLORS DECLARATION OF INTEREST** for items on agenda 2

- 10-11/61 OPEN FORUM FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

It was proposed by LN and seconded by JM that the Council do not put a moratorium on any further lettings on the Dunstall Allotment. This proposal was amended slightly by the Chairman to state that any further lettings should be at the far end of the site.
